The meeting commenced with the recitation of ‘Mool Mantra’

S.Gurmeet Singh Jaura, Member-ISC anchored the program and initiated the meeting agenda-wise.

- 1. Condolence prayer for past members:-** Col.Jagtar Singh Multani, Secretary General formally welcomed all the members attending the meeting. He informed that our two prominent members (Late) S. Sukhdev Singh Laaj and (Late) Principal S. Surinderbir Singh of Ludhiana left for their heavenly abode in the last 6 months. They had been actively associated with ISC for the last more than a decade and had immensely contributed to the ISC.As desired, the house observed 2 minute silence as a mark of respect to these departed souls.
- 2. Confirmation of minutes of Last EC Meeting:-**S. Sher Jagjit Singh, General Secretary read out the minutes of last EC Meeting held on 27th April 2024 and requested the members to suggest any amendment or addition/deletion before confirmation of the minutes. Since none of the members had any objection/suggestion, the minutes were treated as confirmed.
- 3. Review of EC Members List:-**Mrs.Birendra Kaur, Co-Ordinator, Advisory Councils announced the names of all the Executive Committee members of the ISC and sought suggestions from the audience about adding/ deleting any names from the list. The house suggested to go ahead with the same members till any new member is added.
- 4. Review of Homework Tuition Centres(HWTCs):-**Mrs. Sarbjit Kaur, Coordinator, HWTCs explained in detail about the working and progress of all the Free Homework Tuition Centres being run and 6 newly opened centres during the year 2024-2025. She also informed that HWTC Banbhaura has been provided with 3 desktop computers for imparting computer education amongst the children.
- 5. Review of ISC Coaching Centres and Hyderabad Projects:-**Col JS Multani informed that Mukandpur (Nawanshahar) is our flagship centre where the children get 100% admission in various higher educational areas like Nursing, Computer Science, BSc. Medical/Non- Medical courses.
Then he informed about Happy Learning Play School running in Hyderabad and the 3 Computer Centres opened by ISC in Hyderabad and Sri Hazoor Sahib. He also informed that one lady in Hyderabad is keen to help the sikligar children for their

secondary education by purchasing adjoining plot to construct a bigger school building.

6. **Financial help to needy students:-**Col. Multani informed that an amount of Rs._____ has been spent during the year 2024-25 to help the needy bright students for their higher education.
7. **Donations/Financial Postion till Feb 2025:-**S. Sarwan Singh, Manager informed about the donations given by various donors during the financial year 2024-25(till Feb 2025) was Rs. 10. 35 Lakhs.
8. **Review of ISC Advisory Councils:-**Col JS Multani talked about Advisory Councils and rebutting of Government and SGPC Policies and their results.
9. **Review of ISC Amritsar Chapter work:-**S. Jatinder Singh spoke about the HWTCs run by ISC in Amritsar area and also explained how he is focusing on skill development of students through ITIs and Polytechnics to enable children to get employment after passing 10th or 12th standard.
10. **Dr. Navneet Kaur, our member from Jammu** joined online & she suggested that there is good scope of starting online Punjabi classes for students of J&K for which she will prepare the ground work. Then ISC could start Punjabi class through a suitable teacher. She also informed about some government schemes to promote employment among school girls to get training and open their beauty parlours.
