Subject: Complaint Regarding Misleading Headline in The Tribune, Chd.

Respected Sir/Madam,

This is to formally lodge a complaint against *The Tribune*, Chandigarh, for its failure to neither acknowledge nor respond to repeated communications from the International Sikh Confederation (ISC), Chandigarh.

On 2nd December, 2025, ISC wrote a letter to the Editor-in-Chief of *The Tribune* regarding a misleading headline, titled "*Op Sindoor legacy of Guru's valour: Modi*" published on the 26th of November, 2025. <https://www.google.com/amp/s/www.tribuneindia.com/news/punjab/op-sindoor-legacy-of-gurus-valour-modi/amp> (Copy attached)

The letter highlighted serious concerns about misrepresentation of the legacy of the Guru, Guru Tegh Bahadur, and requested an appropriate apology. Subsequently, a reminder email dated 11th February, 2026, was also sent to the Editor-in-Chief reiterating the request (Copy attached). Despite these formal communications, *The Tribune* has neither acknowledged nor issued any response.

Such disregard undermines the responsibility of a leading Daily to uphold journalistic ethics, accuracy, and respect in matters of faith and legacy. Silence in the face of legitimate concerns erodes public trust in the press.

We therefore request the Press Council of India to take cognizance of this matter and impress upon *The Tribune* the need to uphold responsible journalism by acknowledging and addressing the representations made.
