

Empowering Students through Coaching (ESC)

Overview

The International Sikh Confederation (ISC), in collaboration with Bhai Jaitaji Foundation, Chandigarh, proposes a comprehensive initiative to strengthen the academic foundation of youth at multiple stages of schooling. The programs are designed to provide free, structured coaching and support, enabling students to pursue higher education in premier government institutions.

Objectives

- To prepare Class 5 students for admission into Navodaya Vidyalayas.
- To provide free online coaching for Class 9 and 10 students in core subjects.
- To establish a pathway for higher studies through residential coaching for Classes 11 and 12.
- To support NEET aspirants with intensive coaching, including repeaters.

Program Components

1. Navodaya Coaching Centre

- Free study material and books.
- Classes on Sundays, second Saturdays, and holidays.
- Volunteer/teacher honorarium with incentives.

2. Free Online Coaching for Class 9 & 10 (After School Hours)

- Science (3 days/week)
- Mathematics (3 days/week)
- English (1 day/week)

3. Pathway to Higher Studies (+1 and +2)

- Competitive test for selection.
- Free residential coaching, boarding, and lodging.
- Intensive preparation for medical and engineering entrance exams.

4. NEET Repeater Batch

- Free intensive coaching for students reattempting NEET.

Expected Impact

- Enhanced academic performance and competitiveness among students.
- Increased access to premier government institutions for deserving youth.
- Economic relief for parents through free coaching and residential facilities.
- Creation of a sustainable model of educational empowerment within the community.

Implementation

Mukandpur School is proposed as a pilot site for implementation.
